

### Moree Hospital master plan

The master plan for Moree Hospital includes a new building on the existing site as the major component, and complete refurbishment of the existing inpatient building. The new building will house acute services including emergency, imaging, birthing, and the maternity and inpatient unit. Community health, outpatients, and administration will be housed in the fully refurbished building. A central courtyard will be created with opportunities for the design to create a calming environment that is culturally respectful.

There will be one main entry for the public to improve access and security. The Emergency Department will be located near the main entry, and the Ambulance Bay will have its own separate, discrete entry.

The concept design shows the interaction between the new and refurbished buildings, flow of patients, visitors and staff throughout the site and the external finish. The design response respects the site, Country and also the history to provide a modern healthcare setting for all services onsite.



### A place for healing, connection and continuity


The design elements for the hospital have been inspired by the local flora and fauna and the connection to community and Country. Elements of the design that build a healing space for Moree Hospital include:

- Common entry for the public
- Improved connection of services
- Privacy and dignity
- Natural light

- Visual connection to the landscape
- Physical access to the landscape
- Embracing culture
