ENABLING WORKS START

Our expansion is now underway, with Multiplex Constructions appointed the enabling works contractor for our new state-of-the-art John Hunter Health and Innovation Precinct. The enabling works signal the start of the construction process by preparing the site for the main construction works, and are expected to be completed by the end of 2022. The main construction works will then follow.

CHANGES AROUND THE CAMPUS

You will notice some changes around the campus as part of our enabling works, including the establishment of site sheds, temporary signage, environmental clearing, fencing and machinery. Construction activities will take place from 6am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 7am to 5pm on Saturdays. We're working hard to ensure there's minimum impact to our neighbours.

Noise and vibrations

Reducing noise, vibration and dust during construction is our key focus. Noise and vibration monitors will be placed in surrounding buildings and connect into a network that provides real-time monitoring.

There's also several dust mitigation measures on-site, including:

- ensuring fences have shade cloth to help suppress dust
- changing the activities that take place during high winds and poor weather conditions
- · covers on material stockpiles
- application of 'dust block' which seals dirt to ensure it doesn't become airborne
- road sweepers along surrounding roads to collect dust and dirt
- hand-held water sprays and construction vehicle water carts
- daily air monitoring and real time tracking during construction.
