The project team continues to work on delivering the second stage of the Manning Hospital Redevelopment, designed to improve the built environment including flow and connectivity of services for patients, staff and community.

The redevelopment team would like to thank staff, patients and the community who have been involved with the project this year and look forward to continuing these activities in 2023.

In 2022, the project has established a Connecting with Country Project Working Group, ensuring the design and construction incorporates and pays respects to local Aboriginal heritage, and an Arts in Health Working Group to guide the creative aspects of the new areas. A heritage study has been completed to ensure that important service history is preserved.

More consultation will occur shortly, with the release of the schematic design and lodgement of the planning application with the Department of Planning and Environment. Your feedback is welcome.
